### **LUKE 19:1-10 (NLT)**

#### **Jesus and Zacchaeus**

¹ Jesus entered Jericho and made his way through the town. ² There was a man there named Zacchaeus. He was the chief tax collector in the region, and he had become very rich. ³ He tried to get a look at Jesus, but he was too short to see over the crowd. ⁴ So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree beside the road, for Jesus was going to pass that way.

### **LUKE 19:1-10 (NLT)**

#### Jesus and Zacchaeus

- When Jesus came by, he looked up at Zacchaeus and called him by name. "Zacchaeus!" he said. "Quick, come down! I must be a guest in your home today."
- <sup>6</sup> Zacchaeus quickly climbed down and took Jesus to his house in great excitement and joy. <sup>7</sup> But the people were displeased. "He has gone to be the guest of a notorious sinner," they grumbled.

### **LUKE 19:1-10 (NLT)**

#### **Jesus and Zacchaeus**

- <sup>8</sup> Meanwhile, Zacchaeus stood before the Lord and said, "I will give half my wealth to the poor, Lord, and if I have cheated people on their taxes, I will give them back four times as much!"
- <sup>9</sup> Jesus responded, "Salvation has come to this home today, for this man has shown himself to be a true son of Abraham. <sup>10</sup> For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost."

- Change the time and place...and paste my story in...a perfect fit.

- Such was Zacchaeus!

- Long on money, short of stature
- Runs ahead of the pack... secures a limb with a view.
- Gotta see the man who has turned Jericho upside down



#### Jesus' Behavior Is Startling

- Look up to Zacchaeus... and calls him by name.
- Get down here...
  I must stay to your house today.
- He scurried down and welcomed Jesus gladly.
- All of the people are disappointed and critical of such a development.
- \* The home of a 'Sinner'? Yuk.



#### **Zacchaeus is Immediately A New Man**

- Here and now I give half of my wealth to the poor.
- And...any I have cheated will get repaid four times over.

#### It Is The Universal Story

- Guy has all the goodies that money can buy.
- \* Yet has a hole in his heart...goes looking for 'filler'.

- Is confronted by the glory and goodness of God.
- Votes Yes to surrender to the extravagant love of God.

#### Jesus Celebrates This Moment Of Redemption

l'm Zacchaeus


l'm up a tree

I believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God.


I trust Him as my Lord and Savior.
